Dear Bellevue Resident,

The Village of Bellevue Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department is offering homeowners the option of purchasing trees for planting in the Village right-of-way adjacent to your property. Homeowners who are interested may choose from the tree varieties on this year's order form (see attached page).

## **Tree/Planting Information:**

- 2021 trees will be planted in late October to early November. Additional information will be sent before trees are planted.
- Trees must be planted within the Village right-of-way and must be planted within 5-6 feet of the curb.
- The Village of Bellevue will have the final authority on tree placement.
- When ordering trees please keep in mind the following criteria:
  - Large growing trees should be planted approximately 40-50 feet apart
  - o Trees must be planted a minimum of 10 feet from a driveway
  - o Trees must be planted a minimum of 15 feet from fire hydrants, street lights or power poles
- Planting of all trees will be completed and/or coordinated by the Village of Bellevue.
- Trees will be 2 2 ½ inches in diameter and will be balled & burlap.
- Trees may or may not be staked. Stakes are property of the contractor and/or Village of Bellevue and will be removed generally after one year of growth.
- Certain trees may have limited quantities. Availability is on a first come, first serve basis. Homeowners will be contacted in the event the type of tree selected is no longer available.
- Trees come with a two year guarantee. The guarantee assures the health of the tree for two years when not
  disturbed or damaged and is <u>watered</u> sufficiently. The guarantee is not applicable to trees not watered,
  damaged, or disturbed through physical contact or through chemicals, fertilizers, or waste products.
- Homeowners are responsible for watering the tree(s). You can also purchase a tree watering bag with your tree order. These bags hold up to 20 gallons of water and are slow release for the most effective tree watering.
- Trees will have mulch placed around the base of the tree.
