Requirements for Fireworks / Pyrotechnics displays within the Village of Bellevue

The applicant shall comply with all applicable Wisconsin Statutes, Village of Bellevue Ordinances, SPS 314, Wis. Adm. Code, NFPA 1 (Fire Code), NFPA 1123 (for Fireworks Permit), NFPA 1126 (Code for Pyrotechnics before a proximate audience permit), and NFPA 160 (Code for flame effects).

The following items are required and shall be submitted to the Bellevue Fire Department's Fire Prevention Division not less than 30 days prior to a requested date of Fireworks / Pyrotechnics display:

- Village of Bellevue Fire Department Fireworks and Pyrotechnics users application
- Permit fee (see Fee Schedule at www.villageofbellevue.org)
- Certificate of Insurance specifically covering pyrotechnics display naming the Village of Bellevue as an additional insured for the display held under the permit in the aggregate amount of not less than the amount specified in Ch. 237 Bellevue Municipal Ordinance (see Municipal Code at www.villageofbellevue.org)
- List of ALL products being used. This list shall include number, size and brief description
- A Fireworks/Pyrotechnics display plan shall be submitted per NFPA 1126
 The applicant will be notified upon review of the application if there are any concerns that need to be addressed. All required suppression resources required by Code will be made available to the permit applicant during display of fireworks or pyrotechnics. The permit will be signed and returned during the site visit by a representative of the Bellevue Fire Department. A site inspection form will also be filled out and a copy will be supplied to the vendor at the time of the scheduled walk through.

Upon approval of the display permit, "A Notice to Airmen" (NOTAM) thru the American Flight Service Station (AFFS) shall be completed by the permit applicant. This NOTAM will include the time and location, and will be served at minimum 72 hours before time of display. The AFFS phone number is 877-487-6867.

By my signature on Page 1 I hereby agree to the following conditions:

- 1. This permit is valid only for the date and rain date listed herein.
- 2. The applicant shall comply with all applicable Wisconsin Statutes, Village of Bellevue ordinances, Ch. SPS 314, Wis. Adm. Code, NFPA 1 and NFPA 1123 Code for Fireworks Displays (for fireworks permit) or NFPA 1126 Standard for Use of Pyrotechnics before a Proximate Audience (pyrotechnics permit) or NFPA 160 Standard for Flame Effects.
- 3. To file a Certificate of Insurance naming the Village of Bellevue as an additional insured for the fireworks/pyrotechnics display held under this permit in an amount of \$1,000,000.00 for bodily injury to any one person, \$2,000,000.00 for injury to more than one person, and \$1,000,000.00 for damage to property that may arise by reason of use or discharge of fireworks under the permit, specific to the date and type of activity, not less than 15 days prior to the issuance of this permit.
- 4. A violation of any of the terms and conditions herein shall be cause for immediate revocation of this permit and subject the applicant to any citations or fines as allowed by Wisconsin Statute or Village of Bellevue ordinance.
