



Public Works & Parks Maintenance – Seasonal Staff (Summer/Fall 2019)

The Village of Bellevue is one of Brown County's fastest growing municipalities with a population of over 15,000 residents. The Village provides a full range of Public Works and Park related services to our residents. The Village is seeking seasonal members to add to our team that are motivated to make a difference in our community and provide the highest quality of services to our visitors, residents and businesses. Our seasonal employees are an essential part of our Public Works Department and Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department teams to meet a variety of seasonal summer and fall duties. Seasonal Laborers assist regular staff from mid-May through mid-September depending upon assigned duties. Positions may provide up to 40 hours per week for up to 6-months of continuous employment. Additional hours may be available prior to May 1 and after mid-September. Applicants with more limited availability are still encouraged to apply.

Hourly Rate: \$12-14.00/hour DOQ.

Qualifications: Must be 18 years of age. High school diploma or GED certificate. Valid Wisconsin driver's license and access to reliable transportation. Must pass a post-employment background check. Applicants with any prior Parks, Forestry, Recreation, Public Works, or general laborer experience preferred, but not required.
